President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf returned to Monrovia after participating in the first Graduation Convocation of the William V. S. Tubman University in Harper, Maryland County on Thursday, June 19, 2014. The Liberian leader, who is also Visitor to the William V.S. Tubman University, delivered the Commencement Address on the theme: *"The Quest for Quality Education"*. Eighty students – 67 males and 13 females – received degrees in various disciplines.

Dedicate New Administrative Building & Later Visited Sea Erosion Victims

While in Harper, President Sirleaf dedicated the newly renovated Maryland County Administrative Building.

She later toured the site of a devastating sea erosion and flood that displaced several residents of Harper. The Liberian leader presented assorted relief materials to the victims and announced that Government will make a contribution of US\$10,000 to help resettle them.
