Candidates are required to have a terminal degree in EE or a related engineering field from a regionally accredited institution and conferred at the time of hire. Preferred qualifications include industry experience and registration as a Professional Engineer; teaching experience at the undergraduate and graduate levels; success in external funding and a record of scholarship; and interest in outreach activities involving industry, community colleges, and K-12 programs.
