PROGRAMMATIC CONTEXT FOR BEHAVIOUR CHANGE BACKGROUND

ActionAid Liberia with support from UNFPA is implementing a project entitled: Empowered & Fulfilled. It is focusing on advocacy for supportive policy environment and social mobilization targeting both tertiary and secondary beneficiaries in support of increased access to SRH/FP information and services including direct results like addressing barriers for sexually active young people to access contraceptives. In addition, it is looking at the provision of gender sensitive and life skills based comprehensive sexuality education targeting both in and out of school young people to increase their knowledge and influence practices towards teenage pregnancy prevention and seeking SRH/FP information and services. Community behavior change communication for increased awareness and support for young people to access services as part of demand generation targeting both direct and intermediary beneficiaries. The project is also focusing build capacity of institutions and structures at community level to deliver youth friendly sexual and reproductive health and family planning services
