Job Title: Ship Crane (SC) Operators (4 Persons)

Reports to: Operations Department

PURPOSE

Operates Ship Cranes (SC) for discharge and/or loading deep-sea vessels, feeders and inland vessels in the port, within given safety and operational policies and procedures in the most efficient way; provide maximum handling productivity of the equipment.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Conducts operations in a safe manner to ensure all work procedures and safety codes are followed, to prevent injury to all personnel and damage to equipment.
- Carry out all routine pre and post inspection on SC for operational conditions and ensure any defects are reported immediately.
- Operate SC for discharge and loading deep-sea vessels, feeders and inland vessels in the port.
- Operates SC with special equipment attached i.e. for personnel transport or "Out Of Gauge" containers or heavy cargo.
- Report immediately any safety hazards during operations and if necessary stop until such are rectified.
- Report immediately any damage sustained during operations by SC on vessel, containers or other equipment.
- Report immediately any equipment malfunction and assists maintenance when necessary.
- Maintain continuous operation by using "hot seat" changeover at shift changeover times and for operator rest break changeover.
- Maintain the operators cabin, lifts and other spaces in a clean and tidy condition at all times.
- Personal Protective Equipment supplied by the terminal to be worn at all times in designated areas.
- The key impact of this incumbent will be the delivery of operational efficiencies in the terminal. Responsibility for the execution of day to day operational activities.

Critical Qualifications/Skills/Experience

- High school diploma with two years experience in an industrial environment
- Requires at least three or more years of equipment handling or similar work experience in a commercial port environment, or other operator experience that demonstrates an ability to follow instructions and work safely.
- Requires expertise in container and cargo handling activities, developed over a period of time
- Must have complete understanding of operating advanced container gantry cranes.
- Must have a good understanding of container terminal operations, including vessel movements and other yard handling equipment.
- Must have licenses to operate quay crane and all other types of yard handling equipment, including tractor, reach stacker, RTG, mobile crane, and forklift.
- Must have a heavy duty driver's license, issued by the local authority.
- Demonstrates ability to operate at minimum specified average crane productivity moves per hour.
- Requires basic English language skills (numbers, radio and communication instructions).
- Physically fit and able to pass full medical examination.
- No fear of heights & must have a sense of depth and distance perception.
- No colour blindness, good eyesight and hand eye coordination.
- Has knowledge of different types of cranes and their characteristics.
- Has knowledge of different types of vessels and their characteristics.
- Has knowledge of different types of containers and their characteristics.
- Has knowledge of different types of hoisting equipment and their characteristics.
- Understands safety regulations, safe working procedures and safe materials handling procedures and follows safety and work instructions.
- Has the ability to communicate operational instructions and information via two way radio system.
- Understands common used hand signals to communicate without radio system.
