- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf attended a reception in observance of European Union (EU) Day at the residence of its Ambassador to Liberia, Her Excellency, Ms. Tina Intelmannon.

She hailed the European Union (EU) for its enormous contributions to Liberia in its efforts to eradicate the Ebola virus disease as well as its direct budget support and expressed her pleasure that Liberia-EU relations have been taken to a higher level with the elevation of the EU Mission in Liberia to the status of a full EU Delegation.
