

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Friday, October 9, 2015

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf, along with the acting Minister of Agriculture and Chair of the National Investment Commission, held a meeting with the proprietor of the Obasanjo Farm, Dr. Mrs. Obasanjo.

- She later chaired a Special Cabinet Meeting to discuss and harmonize key issues of strategic national importance. Agenda items discussed included an update on the Status of a number of pending items on the President's Legislative Agenda as the National Legislature prepares for its annual break and other conditions precedent on the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) grant; the establishment of a Road Fund condition precedent for MCC grant release. These include the establishment of the Millennium Challenge Account - Liberia (MCA-Liberia) condition precedent for MCC grant release; the Axle Load draft Act - condition precedent for MCC grant release; and the Liberia Electricity draft Act - condition precedent to MCC grant release.

Other were the Local Government draft Act; Liberia National Police (LNP), Bureau of Immigration and Naturalization (BIN) and Firearms draft Acts; the Land Authority draft Act; Domestic Violence draft Act; and the draft act creating the Liberia Agricultural Commodity Regulatory Agency.

The Cabinet also used the Special Session to endorse and further directed the appropriate sector Ministers to work diligently with the 53rd National Legislature and where necessary harmonize all outstanding issues for necessary legislative actions.

Meanwhile, the Cabinet has mandated the Inter-Ministerial Committee to speedily prioritize the fast-tracking of the implementation plan for the refurbishing of the existing Roberts International Airport Terminal.
