

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Tuesday, December 6, 2016**

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf lauded staff of the ECOWAS Commission during a mass gathering at the Commission's headquarters in Abuja, Nigeria, for their commitment, dedication and service to the organization. The Liberian leader met with the President and Vice President as well as Commissioners along with dozens of staff members of the Commission at an elaborate meeting held in the auditorium of the ECOWAS headquarters.
- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf met separately with the Speaker of ECOWAS Parliament H.E. Moustapha Cisse Lo and President of the Community Court of ECOWAS, Justice Jerome Traore in Abuja during day two of her official working visit to the ECOWAS Commission.
- President Ellen Johnson returned home following her participation in a number of events held in Ghana, London and Nigeria. She termed the outcome of the visits as fruitful and in the interest of the country and sub-region. In Ghana she joined other African leaders to witness 7 political parties signed a Code of Conduct. She said in the United Kingdom, she joined the Liberia educational authorities to raise support for education in Liberia while her visit to Nigeria was mainly to become familiarized with ECOWAS Commission activities and functions. Shortly upon her return to the country, President Sirleaf made a brief stopover at the Gbargboe Town Community, in Paynesville, to sympathize and identify with the bereaved families of the two children accidentally killed in the motor accident involving the presidential motorcade.
