The **Government of Liberia** has received funding from the Government of Norway through the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the **Liberia Forest Sector Project (LFSP)**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the **Procurement of Transport Equipment for the Forestry Development Authority, reference: FDA/LFSP/GOODS/04.**

to be delivered to Monrovia, Liberia. Interested eligible bidders are to meet the following qualification criteria: i) Financial Capability and ii) Experience and Technical Capacity. A margin of preference for eligible national suppliers **shall not** be applied. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers*, January 2011 revised July 2014 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
