DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the overall guidance of the FAO Representative in Liberia, and technical supervision of the FAO Regional and Sub-Regional Offices, and in close collaboration with the TCDC consultants and appointed staff, the Livestock Officer shall work under the direct supervision of the National Project Coordinator and shall be directly responsible for the following lines of duties:

- Support international consultant and NPC to identify and train beneficiaries in livestock production
- Ensure FAO's comparative advantage is visible throughout implementation areas;
- Support NPC for organization and facilitation of meetings and workshops;
- Perform other duties as reasonable for successful project implementation.

- ensure that vaccines for poultry are applied according to standard
