The Government of Liberia (GoL) through the Ministry of Transport seeks expression of interest from a reputable firm for the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) to oversee the rehabilitation of the Robert's International Airport Project. This unit will conduct all affairs that will lead to the awarding of contract to a company for the rehabilitation of the RIA and its facilities.

Summary of services include:

- The consultancy firm will perform activities necessary to plan, integrate, package, administer and manage the development and construction of the runway.
- The consultancy firm primary role is to ensure on schedule, under budget delivery of projects in the program consistent with the quality specified by the main and relevant stakeholders, such as RIA, MOT, etc
- The Firm must also have strong knowledge in Airport construction and Aeronautic experience.

The Ministry of Transport now invites eligible consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultancy firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services by submitting detailed information (brochures, past performance records, references of similar assignments executed in the recent past). They must also provide description of work experience both general and on similar assignments. Specific experience on donors funded projects will be an added advantage.
