

Highlights of President Sirleaf's Daily Activities

Monday, July 7, 2014

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf held a Special Cabinet Meeting today to brief them on the violent protest at Arcelor Mittal in Yekepa, Nimba County, update them on the Ebola epidemic in the country, and the continuing flooding in some parts of Monrovia and its environs during heavy rains.

The violence at the multi-million dollar investment left several police officers wounded, saw the holding of employees and contractors – national and expatriates – hostage for up to 20 hours, and millions of dollars worth of property looted and destroyed.

- Later in the afternoon, President Sirleaf met with development partners, including the United Nations Mission in Liberia (UNMIL), members of the diplomatic corps, and representatives of international non-governmental organizations in the C. Cecil Dennis Auditorium.
