

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES

Monday, March 30, 2015

- President Ellen Johnson, today, delivered the Keynote Statement at the opening of a five-day National Constitution Conference (NCC) at the Administration Building in Gbarnga, Bong County.

She stressed that Liberians, through a series of national consultations, have shown and made clear their strong desire to see adjustments made to the country's 1986 Constitution.

The NCC which runs from March 30 – April 2, 2015 will display before the National Conference spoken and written views from the Liberian people received during town hall and stakeholders meetings, electoral district and diaspora consultations as well as thematic session held with specialized government functionaries and interest groups; present to the NCC proposals to amend the Constitution on the basis of issues derived from views/suggestions expressed by the citizens of Liberia during the consultative phase of the review process; and discuss the proposals for amendment and build consensus for onward presentation to the Legislature for consideration.
