



## **Rule of Law Specialist, Legal and Anti-Corruption Midterm Performance Evaluation, Liberia**

The purpose of this evaluation is to examine the appropriateness, performance, and sustainability of the intervention and identify best practices for the remaining years of implementation. USAID/Liberia will use findings from the evaluation to inform more strategic investment in the sector.

### **Position Description:**

SI is seeking a Rule of Law Specialist who will provide technical support to the evaluation team. The Rule of Law Specialist will be working alongside three team members: Team Leader, Economist, and Logistics Coordinator.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Perform desk review and identify additional information required for analysis.
- Provide technical expertise and support the Team Leader's efforts in evaluation design, methodology, and data collection instruments.
- Schedule and interview key stakeholders and beneficiaries.
- Provide ongoing analysis of qualitative and quantitative data.
- Support the preparation and presentation of the key findings and recommendations to USAID/Liberia.
- Write assigned sections of the draft evaluation report in coordination with the team members, taking into consideration feedback from the preliminary findings presentation.



- Work collaboratively with team members throughout design, implementation, analysis, and report writing to complement each other's areas of expertise.

**Qualifications:**

- Must have at least five years of experience and knowledge about the political context in Liberia, particularly legal institutions, rule of law, anti-corruption, and governance.
- A university/college degree in a discipline related to social sciences, political science, law, public administration, or related field.
- Must have strong social analytical skills, specifically in designing and evaluating similar Human and Institutional Capacity Development (HICD) programs.
- Ability to assist with qualitative instrument preparation, key informant interviews, focus group discussions and other data collection, and analysis of collected data.
- Strong English speaking and writing skills are essential.
