

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Sunday, November 1, 2015

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf arrived in Beijing, People's Republic of China at 11:30 a.m. today the start of a four-day State Visit to the world's most populous nation. This follows a successful visit to India where she participated in the 3rd India-Africa Forum Summit.

She was met on arrival at the Beijing International Airport by high-level Chinese officials headed by Vice Foreign Minister Zhang Ming and the Chinese Ambassador to Liberia, H.E. Zhang Yue, as well as Liberia's Ambassador to China, H.E. Mr. McKinley Thomas and other officials of the Liberian Embassy near Beijing, China.

Shortly thereafter, President Sirleaf and delegation departed Beijing for Xiamen City in Fujian Province for a two-day visit to an agriculture, fishing and juice factory. She returns to Beijing on Monday, November 2, 2015 for the start of official activities associated with the State Visit to the People's Republic of China.
