

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES - Sunday, November 29, 2015

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf joined family members and well-wishers to pay homage to Liberia's 18th President, the late William V. S. Tubman, on the occasion of his 120th birth anniversary. She laid a wreath at the mausoleum of President Tubman situated at the grounds of the Centennial Memorial Pavilion in Central Monrovia.

The late William Vacanarat Shadrach Tubman was born in Harper, Maryland County, Liberia, on November 29, 1895. He was President of Liberia from 1944 until his death in a London clinic on July 23, 1971.

President Sirleaf used the occasion to call on all compatriots to remember President Tubman's invaluable contributions made to his country, think about his life and what he represented as well as learn from his works to move the country forward reflecting on his achievements and building upon where he left off.

An Act of Legislature enacted at the 3rd Session of the 42nd National Legislature of Liberia, declared the birth anniversary of Liberia's 18th President, William V.S. Tubman, November 29th of each year as a National Holiday in keeping with the will of the Liberian People.
