

Highlights of the President's Activities

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf addressed the Nation late Sunday afternoon and made a number of new appointments in government especially affecting the Ministries of Public Works, Education, and Health, the National Investment Commission and the Liberia Broadcasting System, among others.

The Liberian President emphasized that as government continues to combat the Ebola virus and strive to achieve the national objective of *zero-new-cases by Christmas*, Government must also attend to the difficult job of recovery.

She indicated that in doing so, this requires a team that is adaptable, responsive, disciplined, loyal, and focused, nothing further, “a team that is understanding of the prevailing challenges, and are resolved to respond by taking appropriate risks to get things done on time,” President Sirleaf said, adding, “It is my job to continuously vet and ready such a team for the challenges we currently face and those that lie ahead.”
