

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES - Thursday, July 23, 2015

- In continuation of the 168th Independence Anniversary celebrations, President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf began the dedication of a number of development projects in Greenville, Sinoe County, one of two counties co-hosting this year's celebrations.

Development projects included the Johnnie N. Lewis Judicial Complex, the newly constructed superintendent's official residence, 15-room executive guest house, a multi-purpose youth center, the renovated James E. Green Sports Stadium and a children's playground.

She also dedicated a number of projects undertaken by the National Port Authority including a guesthouse and a warehouse at the Samuel Ross Port of Greenville.

The Liberian President visited the newly painted Francis J. Grante Memorial Hospital where she interacted with the healthcare workers, medical staff, including expatriate medical staff working at the hospital. She applauded them for giving the health facility a facelift.
