

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES - Tuesday, April 7, 2015

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf addressed the opening the 2015 National General Assembly of the National Union of Organizations of the Disabled (NUOD) at the Mildred Page Hall of the S. Trowen Nagbe United Methodist Church on Tubman Boulevard, Sinkor. The two-day Assembly takes place under the theme: *“Getting to Zero, New Ebola Mainstreaming – Persons with Disabilities and Post-Ebola Recovery Plan.”*

President Sirleaf assured the NUOD that her administration remains committed to adopt an open government that will foster the mainstreaming of persons with disabilities in national governance, policy, political and development processes of the country.

Speaking earlier, the national president of the NUOD, Rev. Fallah S. Boima Cymbianoh, expressed thanks and appreciation for all President Sirleaf and her administration has done for people with disabilities across the country, but noted that more needs to be done to ensure greater inclusion of persons with disabilities throughout the Liberian society.
