

## **Highlights of the President's Daily Activities**

### **Tuesday, December 2, 2014**

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today met with the United Nations System Coordinator for Ebola, Mr. David Nabarro at her Foreign Ministry office. He was visiting Liberia on the last leg of a three- nation tour of Guinea and Sierra Leone to assess the Ebola response, receive updates and brief the leaders of the three worse affected countries.

He was accompanied by the Special Representative of the United Nations Secretary-General to Liberia, Karen Landgren and the Representative of the World Health Organization – Liberia, Peter Graff.

- The President of the World Bank Group, Dr. Jim Yong Kim, at the head of a high-level delegation, met with President Sirleaf at her Foreign Ministry office during a one-day visit to Liberia. On behalf of the delegation, he expressed solidarity with the Liberian people for the losses sustained due to the Ebola outbreak and assured the World Bank Group's commitment to help Liberia in the coming 18 months in five areas.
