

Highlights of the President's Daily Activities
Tuesday, December 9, 2014

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today addressed the opening of a one-day technical meeting on cross border collaboration on the prevention and control of Ebola in West Africa held at the Foreign Ministry's C. Cecil Dennis Auditorium.

The meeting, which brought together national leaders on the Ebola response from Guinea, Sierra Leone, Mali, Cote D'Ivoire, Senegal, Nigeria and host Liberia, examined key issues in the cross-border transmission of the virus and sought to create opportunities for closer cooperation between the affected countries and the Ebola response. It was organized by the Liberian Government and the United Nations Mission for the Ebola Emergency Response (UNMEER).

A special presentation on "getting to zero" with emphasis on lessons from Nigeria's response was made by the delegation from the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

The technical meeting derived recommendations and commitments which will be endorsed at a summit meeting of regional Heads of State later this year.
