

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf has applauded the Firestone Natural Rubber Company and expressed satisfaction for its significant contribution to Liberia's recovery efforts.

The Liberian leader made the assertion following a guided tour of the Hevea Wood Operation Factory situated at Division No. 16. The visit there was to acquaint herself with activities at the Firestone in lower Margibi County.

President Sirleaf lauded Firestone for the meaningful contributions made to the rubber industry; but called on the Management to be more vigilant and begin taking steps in producing gloves and other rubber products right here in Liberia which will expand economic activities and create more jobs in the private sector as a means of improving the lives of Liberians.

Meanwhile, while in Margibi County, the Liberian Chief Executive also inspected a number of public schools in Garzhon, Research Camp, Division #16 including Future Kids Foundation School, True Vine Academy and Memde Town Public School where she presented each of the schools a personal contribution in appreciation of their efforts.
