

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Tuesday, January 23, 2018**

- President George Weah has promised Liberians that he will be an agent of positive change. He humbly thanked Liberians for the trust and hope put in him as their 24<sup>th</sup> President. He expressed joy and pride in the solidarity by friends from across the world that joined Liberians in celebrating a truly historic moment for Liberia. The Liberian leader spoke on Monday, January 22, at the Samuel Kanyon Doe Sports Complex in Paynesville.
- The Liberian leader on Tuesday, January 23, directed the Minister of Information, Hon. Eugene Nagbe; Education Minister, Hon. George Werner; Minister of Internal Affairs, Hon. Varney Sirleaf; the Inspector General of the Liberia National Police, Hon. Gregory Coleman; and the Director of General Services Agency, Hon. Mary Broh to remain serving in their positions until further notice. The Liberian leader further directed that all other Ministries and Public Corporations be supervised by the Director of Human Resource. President Weah also retired the Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces of Liberia, Major General Daniel Ziankahn, and appointed him as Defense Minister-designate subject to confirmation by the Liberian Senate. Deputy Chief of Staff, Brig. General Prince Charles Johnson III, was appointed Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces of Liberia.
- The President later made additional appointments in government pending confirmation by the Liberian Senate where applicable. Those appointed were: Hon. Nathaniel McGill, Minister, Ministry of State for Presidential Affairs; Hon. Gbehzohngar Findley, Minister, Ministry of Foreign Affairs; Hon. Samuel Tweh, Jr., Minister, Ministry of Finance & Development Planning; and Cllr. Charles Gibson, Minister, Ministry of Justice.
