



Request for Applications

Integrated Land and Resource Governance

The Integrated Land and Resource Governance Program (ILRG) is seeking applicants from eligible organizations to complete cost-effective customary land formalization interventions in multiple communities no later than the first quarter of calendar year 2023. ILRG is looking for submissions that address a cost-effective, participatory, and gender-inclusive approach to documenting customary land. ILRG is issuing a Request for Applications following a two-phased process. In Phase 1, interested parties will submit a short Concept Note. Successful applicants will then be invited to submit a Full Application in Phase 2.

Applicants awarded a grant agreement will carry out interventions that contribute to the achievement of ILRG's overarching goal of sustainability of administration of customary land titles, increased access to sustainable livelihoods, participatory use of spatial data to identify, address, and resolve land use planning issues, and gender-inclusive capacity building of community-based governance committees.
