1. The Government of Liberia has received funding from the World Bank toward the cost of the Youth Opportunities Project (YOP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **Procurement of Simple Farming Tools**.
2. The Liberia Agency for Community Empowerment/Youth Opportunities Project now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Supply of Simple Farming Tools to be distributed in 129 communities around the fifteen counties of Liberia.
