

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Sunday, January 28, 2018**

- President George Weah has urged his ECOWAS colleagues to implement reforms in the regional body with emphasis on inclusiveness and solidarity. The Liberian Leader made the call on Saturday, January 27, 2018, in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, during his maiden debut at the Extraordinary Summit of ECOWAS Heads of State and Government held on the margins of the 30<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session of the General Assembly of the African Union. He said a reformed ECOWAS with all Member States having adequate representation will enhance its capacity to deliver in improving the lives and livelihoods of all the citizens of the sub-region.

African leaders attending the 30<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session of the General Assembly of the African Union gave a rousing welcome to Liberian President, George Weah. The Summit, convened under the theme "Winning the Fight against Corruption: A Sustainable Path to Africa's Transformation", is President Weah's first international outing since his inauguration as Liberia's 24th president. The outgoing Chairperson of the Authority of Heads of State, Guinean President Alpha Conde, on behalf of all the African leaders welcomed President Weah and congratulated him on his election and promised AU's support as he steers Liberia to development, lasting peace and prosperity
