The M&E Specialist will conduct training and coaching with USAID staff and IPs on various M&E topics. As LSA plans its activities, the M&E Specialist will represent the needs and interests of USAID and IPs in their sector. He/she will ensure that decisions made are appropriate to the Economic Growth sector.
