

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES

Monday, May 4, 2015

- Former United States President Bill Clinton arrived in Monrovia today as guest of Liberia's President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf during whirlwind one-day visit to Liberia. Upon arrival in the country, former President Clinton held a meeting with President Sirleaf and high-ranking government officials before his visit to the Emergency Operations Center where he held a meeting with the Incidence Management System and partners (local and international) who have assisted the country in its fight against the Ebola virus disease. President Clinton interacted with some Ebola survivors including the leadership of the Ebola Survivors Network.

On the visit overall, President Clinton said it is necessary to support Liberia's post-Ebola recovery plan and assist President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf rebuild the country's healthcare delivery system, specifically in training more healthcare workers so just in case there is another outbreak of the disease, they will be able to deal with it expeditiously.

President Clinton and his daughter Chelsea are on a nine-day, four country tour to observe foreign projects the Clinton Global Initiative has supported connected to healthcare, global warming, wildlife protection, education and agriculture.
