

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES

Saturday, February 21, 2015

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf departed the country today for official visits to the United States of America and Belgium.

The Liberian leader makes a brief stop-over in the Emirate of Sharjah, one of the states of the United Arab Emirates (UAE), to share her experience in Crisis Management at the International Government Communication Forum there.

Following her brief visit to the UAE, she then travels on to Washington, D.C., United States of America where she will meet President Barrack Obama at the White House on Friday, February 27, 2015.

The Liberian leader will also meet with the Administration officials, Congressional leaders and other stakeholders. She will also speak at an event hosted by Democratic Senator Chris Coons and the U.S. Institute of Peace on February 26, 2015.

President Sirleaf will then travel to Brussels, Belgium to participate in an Ebola Conference organized by the European Union (EU). The conference will bring together the three most affected Mano River Union countries (Liberia, Guinea, and Sierra Leone) and will see the Liberian President perform the role of Spokesperson for the three countries.

From Brussels, the Liberian leader returns to the United States, where she will participate in the 20th anniversary celebration of the Beijing Platform for Action at the UN Headquarters in New York.

She is expected home on March 13, 2015.
