The M&E Specialist will conduct training and coaching with USAID staff and IPs on various M&E topics in the Health sector. As LSA plans its activities, the M&E Specialist will represent the needs and interests of USAID and IPs in their sector. He/she will ensure that decisions made are appropriate to the Health sector.

- Provide support for needs Assessment on Performance Management for IPs and Mission.

- Provide reports to USAID upon request and deploy the Performance Management Specialists for site visits.
