The Republic of Liberia has received Financing from the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA), the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), the International Development Association (IDA) and the African Development Bank (AfDB) toward the cost of the Project Preparatory Advance for Integrated Public Financial Management Reform Project-II (IPFMRP-II), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for procurement of hardware, data storage and network devices.

The bidding document in English may be purchased by interested Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee<sup>1</sup> of US\$50.00 (Fifty United States Dollars). The method of payment will be direct deposit. The banking details will be provided upon request. The bidding document will be furnished upon presentation of payment receipt.
