

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES

- President Sirleaf departed Greenville, Sinoe County for Barclayville, Grand Kru County, co-host of Liberia's 168th Independence Anniversary. She praised the Ministry of Public Works team headed by deputy minister Claude Langley who constructed a 120-foot Bailey bridge over the Darbawulor creek that connects Greenville to Barclayville through Taybu 1 and Taybu 2 and has cut the transportation time of the 166 kilometer road between the two capital cities by nearly two hours.

During her visit to Barclayville, the Liberian leader visited ongoing renovation work at the Barclayville City Hall, the newly constructed administrative building in Jloh Statutory District and the presidential guest house where she held a meeting with the local leadership including the Grand Kru County Legislative Caucus on ongoing preparations.

She returned to Greenville, Sinoe County later in the evening.
