

Highlights of the President's Activities

Thursday, October 23, 2014

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today met with the Chairperson of the African Union Commission (AUC), Her Excellency Dr. Nkosazana Dlamini Zuma, and her 14-member delegation. They paid a one-day official visit to Liberia, one of the three worst affected countries hit by the Ebola virus disease.

At a press stakeout later, Dr. Zuma expressed solidarity with the government and people of Liberia and also extended sympathy to those who passed due to the Ebola crisis. She commended Liberia for its fortitude and courage in facing the difficult situation. “We hope that you will continue and sooner rather than later you will be successful in dealing with Ebola,” she said.

Earlier, President Sirleaf heartedly welcomed the first woman Chairperson of the African Union to Liberia. She thanked Dr. Zuma for the solidarity and support visit and for all that the African Union is doing to support Liberia and the other two neighboring countries in the fight against the Ebola virus disease.
