USAID intends to award a firm fixed priced multi-year construction contract to furnish and install water pipes line at two water utilities located in Sanniquellie (Nimba County) and Voinjama (Lofa County), Liberia and the construction of water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) infrastructure in 26 specified health facilities in Bong, Nimba and Lofa counties Liberia. Minimum Education Requirement

The QC Officer must have a minimum BSc degree in the field of Civil Engineering, Construction Technology, Hydraulic Engineering, Sanitary Engineering, or equivalent technical field.

Experience Requirements

- The Quality Control Officer (QCO) shall have a minimum of eight years demonstrated professional experience in the oversight of inspection teams and in verification of quality of construction with respect to specifications and drawings.
- A minimum five years of professional experience as a QC Officer or similar role.
- Experience is interpreting shop drawings and specifications Specific experience is in project reporting, project performance monitoring, coordination of resources and personnel on multiple work forces, health, safety and environmental compliance and quality assurance is required.
- Specific experience in the construction of WASH facilities and/or municipal water systems.



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- The candidate must be familiar with construction and logistics in rural Liberia or similar environments, able to interact with key stakeholders, and a working knowledge of, and experience with international development or construction projects.

Anticipated Program Role

The quality Control Engineer will have the responsibility for the implementation of the network expansion in the 2 cities (Sanniquellie and Voinjama) and for WASH in Health Facilities.

The QCE shall be responsible for management of Contractor's inspection teams and for preparation of the quality control and inspection plan. The QCE shall be full time in the field during construction works.

The incumbent shall monitor overall construction performance with regard to technical quality, implementation of the quality control plan and compliance with design and specification requirements.

The QC Officer shall also serve as the Quality Assurance Specialist (QAS) for the planning, implementation and execution of a quality assurance program that includes the full range of quality principles, concepts, testing, inspection techniques, surveillance and evaluations related to quality assurance functional programs of all waterworks, and associated systems and structures.
