Job purpose

The Mary's Meals Warehouse Coordinator is responsible for the accountability and safe custody of goods in the warehouse and Marys' Meals Store Room. The position is responsible for ensuring an effective flow of goods in and out of the warehouse and store room, with complete supporting documentation.

Key activities

1 Warehouse and Stores management

- Ensure compliance to warehouse manual guidelines and organisational policies and procedures
- Keep abreast of the supply chain of Mary's Meals food to prepare storage space and offloading the goods
- With the support of Logistics Manager, ensure accurate and timely labelling of stacks
- Ensure all necessary paperwork is recorded for receipt and dispatch of goods entering and leaving the warehouse respectively
- Conduct daily spot checks
- Maintain an up-to-date inventory register for stock movement
- Establish stock optimal stock balances
- Ensure availability of valid stock at all times and flag to budget holders when stock comes below optimal levels
- Take periodic inventories and participate in monthly and end of year inventory stock take
- Ensure warehouse documents are up to date, Bin and Stock cards are updated daily and entries registered in the ledger files.

3 Safety and security

- Ensure Vehicle movement in and out of the warehouse is properly coordinated, safe and secure
- Limit traffic in and out of the warehouse to loading, offloading, cleaning and stock check
- Prevent slips, trips and falls by enforcing security guidelines

4 Reporting

- Prepare monthly reconciliation of stock movements
- Prepare monthly stock report and provide and address stock variances between physical stock take and monthly stock report
- Prepare damaged stock and loss report
- Adjust stock movement in the stock ledger
- Prepare a monthly distribution planner, mapping out schools per district and share with the program before start of any food deliveries.
- Provide justification for stock variances in a timely manner
