

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Wednesday, November 4, 2015**

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today held discussions with dozens of private sector companies and investors with investment interests in the Liberian economy and encouraged them to embrace the rather flourishing business climate currently being enjoyed as the country seeks to recover from the effects of the Ebola virus disease.
- She later met with the leadership of Liberians residing in China as well as Liberian students pursuing studies in China during a visit to the Chancery. Both groups welcomed the Liberian leader and acquainted her with a number of issues confronting them. They appealed for her intervention to help address those challenges.

She thanked her compatriots for peacefully residing in China and respecting the laws and promised to work with Ambassador McKinley Thomas and the Embassy near Beijing to mitigate some of their concerns.

Later, President Sirleaf and delegation were honored with a luncheon by Ambassador Thomas and staff of the Liberian Embassy at the Westin Hotel in Beijing.
