Construction Supervisor

Created in 1979 and now operating in over 50 countries around the world, Action Against Hunger is one of the major actors in fighting hunger. Active in Liberia since 1990, Action Against Hunger has become one of the main humanitarian and development actors in the country focusing on Nutrition, Health, Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS) as well as Food Security and Livelihoods (FSL), Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) to address the underlying and root causes of nutrition insecurity. Action Against Hunger's work in Liberia has evolved significantly over the years from emergency response to longer-term development, aiming at ensuring the provision of nutrition services within the health system; promoting and implementing FSL and WASH interventions; and developing strong partnerships with local civil society and national NGOs as well as the Government of Liberia. Through the years, Action Against Hunger has developed a strong acceptance within the communities in the areas of interventions. Action Against Hunger Country office is located in Monrovia.

I. Summary of position

Action Against Hunger is seeking highly motivated professionals to join our team as **Construction Supervisor**. The Construction Supervisor will be a team player who collaborates with all staff, partners and other third parties engaging into construction activities with Action Against Hunger. He/ She will support the mission and values of Action Against Hunger by effectively ensuring quality and safety standards are met, and maintaining accurate project records. He/ She will foster a positive and inclusive work environment, ensuring that all persons involved in construction activities are motivated, well-supported, and aligned with the organization's goals to maximize Action Against Hunger's impact on the communities we serve through its construction initiatives.

II. Some key job responsibilities

Mission 1: Supervise and monitor construction activities under BEHOL Program from conception to completion as guided by construction manager:

- Ensuring contractors work together to deliver quality work adhering to strict deadlines.
- Monitoring construction processes, and providing onsite trainings if required
- Ensuring adherence to health and safety regulations at all times.
- Performing equipment, material, and routine site inspections.
- Ensure coherence in construction sites to complete works as scheduled.
- Scheduling regular meetings with contractor staff, site inspectors, managers, and staff.
- Writing progress reports, and presenting them to construction manager, and relevant staffs.
- Staying up-to-date with safety codes and advancements in construction.
- Processing paperwork and traveling to multiple sites as required.
- Collaborate with other project staff to keep them updated on work progress.
- Take instructions and advice from construction manager as required and deemed appropriate
- Report any mismatch in planned works and propose corrective actions.
- Ensure adherence to work standards, costs and regulations.

- Ensure effective communication and participative approach of work within the partners and stakeholders involved in the program implementation.
- Participate in field visits by Construction and WASH stakeholders, donors whenever requested
