The Government of the Republic of Liberia has received funding from the African Development Bank Group (AfDB) towards the cost of the Paving of the Kelipo – Putuken - John Davis Town(61.5km) under the Mano River Union Road Development and Transport Facilitation Programme (MRU/RDTFP) Phase III and intends to use part of the proceeds of MRU/RDTFP Phase III funding for payments under the contract for the provision of Communications & Visibility Consultancy Services.

The service will involve ensuring that stakeholders, beneficiaries, and the general public are regularly informed about the programme's objectives, progress, benefits, impact, and the financial support provided by the African Development Bank (AfDB), Government of Liberia, and other partners. The service will also ensure the development and implementation of a Communication Strategy with a Communication and Visibility Plan (CVP), in accordance with African Development Bank (AfDB) guidelines, to enhance the visibility of the project at the national, regional, and community levels.

The Ministry of Public Works now invites eligible consultants (firms) to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultants **must** provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (i) information detailing the company's existence and areas of expertise (ii) list of similar assignments and experience in similar conditions, (iii) list of overall permanent and temporary staff in fields related to the assignment (iv) evidence of past performance (v) any other relevant information. Consultants may constitute joint ventures to enhance their chances of qualification.

Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list, and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's ***"Procurement Policy and Methodology for Bank Group Funded Operations" (BPM), dated October 2015*** using the Least Cost Selection (LCS) method, which is available on the Bank's website at <http://www.afdb.org>. The MPW is under no obligation to shortlist any consultant who expresses interest. The assignment is expected to be carried out intermittently throughout the life of the road construction period of thirty-six (36) months.
