The Factory Maintenance Superintendent shall be responsible for but not limited to the following duties:

- Executing all physical and virtual inspections of machinery and fabrication works to identify problems and necessary action.
- Preparing weekly plan to ensure coverage of forecasted workloads.
- Assigning jobs to machinists and monitoring completion of tasks
- Ensuring that tasks are performed in accordance with environmental, health and safety policies and procedures to ensure the wellbeing of teammates and visitors.
- Reviewing shift reports and taking corrective measure where applicable.
- Evaluating and monitoring stock levels and making timely request for replenishments.
- Fabricating doors, window bars, and rapidly collecting tanks for Estates 'operation.
- Conducting training for machinists using work instructions and safety modules.
- Providing accurate information and regularly providing progress updates as required by management.
- Performing performance appraisals of direct reports at defined intervals.
- · Performs other duties as assigned.
