Firestone Liberia is seeking to hire a **Factory Maintenance Supervisor** who will provide energy support for smooth operation of Block Rubber Plant by ensuring adequate supply of steam and maintaining good wood inventory, and availability of water. Works closely with Boiler Superintendent for planning maintenance activities of the boiler.

The Factory Maintenance Supervisor shall be responsible for but not limited to the following duties:

- Planning and executing the day-to-day maintenance and operations of the entire Boiler system and Dryers at the Block Rubber plant.
- Ensuring stock level of chemicals and spare parts and maintaining boiler structural integrity.
- Monitoring steam pressure daily both at the boiler and in the plant and acting.
- Monitoring and recording all chemical usage to ensure boiler water properties are maintained.
- Overseeing all operational and maintenance activities of the boiler including steam line and valve installations and repairs in the plant
- Ensuring all shifts are adequately manned to produce required steam.
- Conducting daily inventory of woodbins and reporting status.
- Quantifying wood consumption and total energy generation.
- Ensuring each maintenance or repair task is performed in accordance with environmental, health, and safety policies and procedures to ensure the safety of teammates and visitors.
- Monitoring and Evaluating pH properties of boiler water and acts where necessary.
- Monitoring activities of boiler technicians/operators and ensure good performance.
- Evaluating shifts reports and acts where necessary.

Requirements:

Minimum Qualifications: Education, Experience, Knowledge, Skills and abilities-

- Degree in Mechanical Engineering or a related field.
- Minimum Two years' experience in boiler operation and maintenance
- Ability to communicate technical information.
- Good organization and computer skills.
- Knowledge in physical chemistry, and thermodynamics processes

Working Conditions:

Must be able to work under pressure; respond to emergency calls; work under sounds of heavy equipment such as rubber processing machines; wears job related clothing prescribed for the department including PPEs. Must abide by all safety rules including no wood policy.
