## Honorable Members of the National Legislature Present; Minister Bangalu & Officials of the Ministry of Youth & Sports The One United Nations Family; Our Others Partner Institutions; Officials of the Ministry of Health; Official of the Ministry of Gender, Children and Social Protection; Other Members of the Cabinet Present; Representatives of our Development Partners; Our Dear Youths of Liberia; The Media; Distinguished Ladies and Gentlemen:

I can only say, "To God be all the glory" for yet another day when we are set to record success in our endeavor to reposition our country and people, especially the youth.

We are here to meet and inspire our partnership people who are ready to help us lift this country unto a new and nobler platform. And in so doing I remind all that we welcome people not merely based on the merit of capacity, but more importantly on ability, motivation, willingness and character that has propelled them to answer to calls of nation building, community development and family enrichment.

As they persist in their nation-breaking venture of destroying our youth, which amounts to tampering with the future and destiny of this nation, we will equal their challenge by leaving no stone unturned in making life miserable for them by disrupting their criminal enterprise.

And so we can say without hesitation that this is war. Let the drug lords understand they are in the same skin as heartless criminals, committing crimes against humanity by decimating the future of the nation's future generation. I say loud and clear therefore that we assure them that, from this moment forward, they should expect us to fight them with every legal tool and means available to us. They must be seen as enemies of our people who deserve no place in this nation. We will let them have no rest.

On the flip side of this scourge of drug abuse, we cannot let our guard down. While we fight the supply side, we vow to pay no less attention to the demand side. In furtherance of Deliverable <u>Objective 4</u>, we plan to shortly engage the National Legislature and other stakeholders to facilitate our campaign of mobilization against drugs and substance abuse in Liberia. We will lift and run with this program, doing it with commitment to its objectives, modalities and strategies aimed at getting it right. Even more so, we will rally support for it locally and internationally. Collectively, we have to make it work.

## So My Dear Graduates;

The Government of Liberia is here to prove you right. Considering the proud decision, you made to go through this positive change, I hereby declare you "Pioneer Beneficiaries" of the Liberia front-line patriots on the war against drug lords. By your dare to make the right choice, you are Ambassadors of the Rescue Mission.

Right on from here, we will ask you to lead our tour of Kush Joints and Ghettos in Monrovia and out of Monrovia. Our tour is intended to reach out to your friends (our daughters and sons), so as to strengthen them to build the courage to follow your steps. I want to encourage them to join this new community of youth that you have just created today. Indeed you now make up the Community of Reclaimed Youth. Thank you for your leadership.

Sincerely speaking, this is why I sought the opportunity to serve my country and people as the President of our cherished Republic. It is heart-warming to meet people like you. Many of you, my fellow citizens and compatriots, are on the move in one direction or another but without that genuine help, you are left without what it takes to push you forward.

Let me reiterate that our emergency intervention to this campaign against drugs and substance abuse only strengthens the current At Risk Youth Program borne out of the GoL and the One UN Joint Concept Note. This will not be limited to 100 days, after which we then roll back to "status quo ante."
