**JOB SUMMARY**

The Samaritan's Purse (SP) WASH Program is starting a new Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) program in Nimba County. The program targets communities and institutions to reduce the incidence of waterborne and hygiene-related diseases and improve access. The Driller will be responsible for the drilling activity using a village drill and will take good care of it.

**DETAILED RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASKS**

- Maintains a personal, active relationship with Jesus Christ and is a consistent witness for Jesus Christ.
- Conduct the overall drilling operations using the village drill.
- Monitor and timely report the overall condition of the drill machine and other drilling equipment to the drilling operation coordinator.
- Inspect and make a checklist for the drilling supplies and equipment and the proper use of tools.
- Ensure the proper setting of the drill machine before commencing the drilling work.
- Provide the necessary information for well completion.
- Prepare and submit the list of drilling supplies and other items required periodically.
- Support in identifying and selecting suitable sites for drilling operations.
- Lead the site selection team to ensure that drilling operations are aligned with the most promising and sustainable locations, enhancing the success rate of drilling projects
- Be willing to travel through rough terrain, possibly on a motorbike, to reach remote communities.
- Attend daily morning devotions and participate in prayer support for the ministry, its donors, and volunteers.
- Maintain a strong Christian witness to colleagues, vendors, charitable beneficiaries, and the general public.
- With a generous and serving spirit, perform all other tasks & responsibilities assigned for the benefit of SP.
