**SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, AND COMMISSIONING OF 100kVA

1. The **Government of the Republic of Liberia** has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the **Liberia Urban Resilience Project (LURP)** and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards payments under the contract for **Supply, Delivery, Installation, and Commissioning of 100kVA Hybrid Solar Power System for the Ministry of Public Works**.
2. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank’s Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through Letter of Credit.
3. The Ministry of Public Works (MPW) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for **Supply, Delivery, Installation, And Commissioning of 100kVA Hybrid Solar Power System for the Ministry of Public Works** as shown below:

NB: More details on the required specifications are contained in the bidding documents. A margin of preference shall **NOT** apply.

4. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding procedures using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “**Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers**” dated July 2016 and revised November 2017 and August 2018, updated November 2020 and updated

September 2023 (fifth edition) (“Procurement Regulations”) and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the address below and inspect the bidding documents during office hours from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm on Tuesday, **July 30, 2024**. A site visit (at the expense of interested applicants) will be conducted on **August 6, 2024**.

5. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased and collected by interested eligible bidders at the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **United States Dollars One Hundred (US\$100.00)** cash to the PMU Finance Officer. Upon payment of the tender fee, bidders are required to obtain an official receipt from the Accounts Unit before collecting the documents from PMU Procurement Office at the **Ministry of Public Works**. No arrangements have been made for other methods of delivery of bidding documents.

6. Sealed Bids must be clearly marked **Supply, Delivery, Installation, And Commissioning of 100kVA Hybrid Solar Power System for the Ministry of Public Works**, and to the address below delivered to the PMU procurement unit on or before **August 29, 2024, at 11:00 am** and will remain valid for a period of **119** days after the bid submission deadline. Electronic Bidding will **NOT** be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend in the LURP Conference Room of the Ministry on **August 29, 2024, at 11:05 am GMT**

Note: Bid Security is 1% of the bidder’s bid price.

7. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder’s beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.

8. For bidders’ eligibility, bids must be submitted together with the following: -
