Bomi Community College (BCC) is a public land-grant government-supported institution of higher learning located in Tubmanburg City, Bomi County. BCC has been operating as the first community-based college initiative in Liberia since August 2005 and accredited by the National Commission on Higher Education in 2009. BCC was subsequently enacted by an Act of Legislature on September 19, 2012 with mandate to administer co-educational institution of teaching, learning and research within the Western Region of Liberia including Bomi, Grand Cape Mount, Gbarpolu and Rural Montserrado Counties. We strive to prioritize people's most urgent needs, empowering lives and promoting quality education and professional development for a large youthful population in the region. BCC offers Associate of Arts degrees in agriculture, business, education, nursing, criminal justice and certification in TVET with specialization in masonry, plumbing and carpentry. BCC also offers a "C" Certificate extension program in teacher-training education in Bopolu, Gbarpolu County. All academic programs and TVET are accredited by the National Commission on Higher Education, Liberian Board of Nursing and Midwifery and other relevant authorities in Liberia.

1. Technical Trainers Position " Electricity, Fitter, Plumbing, and Machinery"

Terms of Reference (TOR):

- Job Purpose: Each Technical Trainer will be responsible for providing instruction and training in their respective trade—Electricity, Fitting, Plumbing, or Machinery.
- Key Responsibilities: Teach theory and practical aspects of their trade, assess student progress, maintain safety protocols, and develop course materials.

Roles and Responsibilities:

• Provide both theoretical and practical training in the Electricity, Fitter, Plumbing and Machinery trades.

- Develop, update, and implement curriculum materials in line with industry standards.
- Conduct regular assessments, evaluate students' progress, and provide feedback.
- Ensure a safe training environment by strictly adhering to safety protocols.
- Maintain training tools and equipment in good working condition.
- Collaborate with other trainers to ensure consistent teaching standards across all trades.

Qualifications:

- **BSc** in Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, or related field, except for Plumbing you have certificate.
- A minimum of **five years of professional experience** in the relevant trade OR equivalent professional experience.
- Strong practical knowledge of the trade and teaching experience is an advantage.

2. Monitoring and Evaluation Officer

Terms of Reference (TOR):

Job Purpose: The M&E Officer will monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of TVET programs to ensure they meet set goals and objectives.

Key Responsibilities: Develop monitoring tools, conduct assessments, collect and analyze data, and prepare reports.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Design and implement monitoring and evaluation systems for the college's training programs.
- Collect and analyze data to assess the effectiveness and impact of programs.
- Provide recommendations for program improvements based on evaluation findings.
- Work closely with faculty and staff to maintain and improve program quality.
- Ensure that all monitoring and evaluation activities align with the college's mission and goals.
